Drum Clamp

Drum Clamp - Forklifts are utilized to handle lifting, storing and moving pallets. For companies which handle products in drums, you have to use an attachment so as to lift, store and move them. There are various drum forklift accessories which you could get for all of your drum moving, lifting and storing needs. These attachments are specifically used so as to handle drum containers - thus there is no risk of damage to the item or drum container whenever they are moved, lifted or stored.

Drum Positioner And Grab

The drum positioner could be used to load and unload drums off of racks, drum stands and vehicles. These are offered in three or four tine models. This accessory is totally automatic, thus allowing the operator to operate all from the comfort of the forklift seat. Able to move steel, large and extra large plastic drums, its capacity is 210 liters. This particular accessory is meant for drum pyramid stacking.

The drum grab can be mounted to the forks, with a designed objective of dealing with steel drums which have rolling hoops. Although the initial reason for the design was to deal with steel drums with rolling hoops, the drum grab can help accommodate plastic drums too. Drum capacity maximum is 210 liters for steel drums with rolling hoops and 220 liters for plastic drums.

The Rotator

The drum rotator is actually a forklift accessory which mounts on to the blades themselves. The purpose of the drum rotator is to be able to pick up the drum and turn it upside down. The drum fits in to the rotator using a steel clamp that fits over the center of the drum. The rotation is done by either a continuous loop chain or a crank handle. The crank handle is intended for operations that occur beneath shoulder level. For operations which must happen above shoulder level, the continual loop chain will be utilized.

Drum tines are simple fork mounted accessory which could be meant for unstacking or stacking 210-liter metal drums. Stacking involves nothing elaborate, just easy horizontal placement of the drums. The carriage-mounted attachments decrease the load center of the drums.

Automatic Tongs

Drum tongs are available both semi-automatic and automatic units which can be utilized in the open topped and tight head metal drum styles. The drum tongs can likewise be attached in many various ways to the lift truck. One method is to connect them beneath a fork-mounted hook. One more way is to attach them to a fork-mounted jib or a carriage mounted jib. Either the semi automatic and the automatic have a drum capacity of 210 liters. With the automatic, there is no requirement for the operator to ever leave the seat of the lift truck.

Rim Grip Handler

Whenever drums need storage with limited area accessible, the Rim Grip Drum Handler is the ideal choice in drum forklift accessories. This accessory would work for both the 210 L drums along with 120 L drums. The Rim Grip Handler operates by utilizing metal jaws in order to grab the rim of the drum. It lifts the drum and puts it down without needing any space between all of the drums. The standard model utilized in the business is a zinc-plated handler, though, this particular accessory comes accessible in stainless steel for the food and drink industry.
